
Safeguarding Responsibilities of Elders and Pastoral Friends

- Follow the Safeguarding Policy and Procedures and abide by the Code of Conduct
- Offer pastoral care and support where requested to all those who have been affected by abuse
- Where appropriate, work with the AM Safeguarding Coordinator to ensure boundaries are set, supervision and pastoral care is in place for offenders and those who may pose a risk, and that terms of any written agreements with those who pose a risk are followed

Both these roles will have a *Safeguarding Induction* before starting the role and *Basic Safeguarding Training* refreshed at least every 3 years.

Additional responsibility of Convenor of Pastoral Friends

- Jointly review Local Meeting practice and report to trustees annually using the Local Meeting Annual Safeguarding Report (SR9a).
