To benefit from the training courses and resources, Friends should first join the organisation by going to its website, creating a user profile, and linking it to our Area Meeting:

- 1. Go to https://thirtyoneeight.org/log-in and click on "Create a user login here".
- Create your user profile inventing your own password. The organisation name is West Wiltshire & East Somerset Area Meeting. Click "Submit" and wait for an email to activate your profile.
- 3. Contact the AM Safeguarding Coordinator to arrange for your user profile to be linked to our Area Meeting's membership. You should receive a further email from Thirtyone:eight finalising this step.

Once your profile has been linked, you will be able to look at resources in the Knowledge Hub and to book training courses.
